Uniform and Policy Requirements 2024

At Queen of Angels Catholic School, we take great pride in fostering a nurturing and disciplined environment that reflects our values and dedication to your child(ren)'s education and growth. As we look ahead to the new school year, we want to remind you of some important guidelines to ensure a smooth and harmonious school experience for everyone.

Uniform and Appearance:

School Uniform: Students are expected to wear their school uniform with pride everyday - please keep it clean and presentable.

PE Strip: Our uniform policy also requires students to wear a complete PE strip for every gym class. This includes crested shorts, crested t-shirt, and a pair of appropriate indoor and outdoor running shoes.

Socks: Students are required to wear white or navy-blue socks with no logos.

Shoes: Only black, no logo shoes with non-marking soles are permitted.

Makeup: Blush, eyeshadow, and eyeliner are not permitted.

Nails: Acrylic/plastic nails and coloured nail polish are not permitted.

Daily Essentials:

Lunchbox: Please ensure your child brings a lunchbox every day.

Water Bottle: Staying hydrated is important; a refillable water bottle is a must. We are a water-only school (except for milk and PSG hot lunch days).

Backpack: Each student should bring a backpack to carry their school materials and personal items, it also helps keep our classrooms tidy.

Cell Phones:

As with other schools across the country, Queen of Angels School has a "no cell from bell-to-bell" policy. This includes smart watches. If your child needs to contact you, they may come to the office.
